PUBLIC COMMENT

Dr. Roth allowed time for public comment.

Dr. Roth also took the opportunity to welcome Dr. Bradley to the board as its newest member.

MINUTES

Motion by Dr. Bradley, seconded Ms. Spillers, to approve the minutes of the April 6-7, 2010, meeting of the board and the June 18, 2010, and June 28, 2010, teleconference meetings of the board.

Vote: Unanimous.

Motion carried.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

INTERIM DIRECTOR

Dr. Roth thanked Mr. McCollum for his service as the interim director of the board upon Ms. Price's retirement.

FISCAL REPORT

Mr. McCollum reported that the board would receive a final fiscal report for fiscal year 2010 at the October 2010 board meeting following the final close-out of all payments for that fiscal year on August 31, 2010. Mr. McCollum indicated that spending for the current fiscal year is on target.

The board members received a copy of the proposed budget for fiscal year 2011 in their folders.

RENEWALS

Mr. McCollum reported that applications for renewal of all dental licenses were mailed July 2, 2010.

DATABASE PROJECT

Mr. McCollum reported that the database project is currently on track. The new database may go live in late October or early November.

LEGAL UPDATE

Ms. Weeg introduced Sara Scott as a new assistant attorney general with the Attorney General's office. Ms. Scott will be working with Ms. Weeg on some of the licensing boards. Ms. Weeg reported that the Attorney General's office has started to take a team approach with various state agencies.

Ms. Weeg reported that Dr. Bell's case was dismissed by the 8th Circuit. The case has now concluded.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Motion by Ms. Beasler, seconded Ms. Meier, to nominate Dr. Roth to the position of chairperson.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR APPOINTMENT

Dr. Roth reported that the search committee was comprised of Dr. Roth, Ms. Price, Ms. Weeg, Ms. Parsons and Dr. Kuempel. The committee's recommendation for the position of executive director is Ms. Melanie Johnson. Ms. Johnson is an attorney and has worked at the state for a number of years.

Motion by Dr. Rovner, seconded Ms. Meier, to accept the committee's recommendation.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Dr. Roth indicated that Ms. Johnson will not begin immediately. Mr. McCollum will continue to serve as interim director until she begins employment at the Iowa Dental Board.

Ms. Johnson took the opportunity to thank the search committee for their time. Ms. Beasler also thanked the search committee and Mr. McCollum for their time.

DENTAL HYGIENE COMMITTEE

ELECTION OF DENTAL MEMBER

Motion by Ms. Parsons, seconded Ms. Beasler, to appoint Dr. Roth to the Dental Hygiene Committee as the dental member.

Motion carried.

COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

Mr. McCollum reported that there are no current recommendations for IPRC member appointments. Staff has attempted to find replacements for the former committee members; however, information is not available at this time. Dr. Roth thanked the committee members for their service.

Dr. Roth indicated that the Anesthesia Credentials Committee (ACC) would like to nominate Kaaren Vargas, D.D.S. to the ACC committee as she is a pediatric dentist with a moderate sedation permit. Given the recent changes to board rules regarding sedation, and in particular, the sedation of pediatric patients, the committee members felt that it was important to have a committee member who has experience in the sedation of pediatric patients.

Motion by Ms. Meier, seconded Ms. Spillers, to accept the committee's recommendation.

Dr. Roth recommended adding Ms. Spillers to the Continuing Education Advisory Committee and the Licensure and Registration Committee, adding Dr. Bradley to the Dental Assistant Registration Committee and removing Dr. Roth from the Dental Assistant Registration Committee.

Dr. Roth recommended that Dr. Grimes serve on the CRDTS Dental Examination Review Committee, and that Ms. Beasler continue on the Dental Hygiene Examination Review Committee. Dr. Roth indicated that he would like to serve on the Steering Committee.

DENTAL HYGIENE EXAMINATION REVIEW COMMITTEE REPORT

Ms. Beasler reported that the Dental Hygiene Examination Review Committee met the previous weekend. The examination statistics, which were available to date, were discussed. There are approximately 1300 dental hygienists who will test this year. There will be a few changes to the dental hygiene examination for next year based on feedback from interested parties.

The examinations are going very well. A number of states are reported to be adding the CRDTS examinations.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

ANESTHESIA CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE (ACC)

Dr. Roth reported that the ACC has reviewed and recommended permits for a number of licensees.

PERMIT APPLICATION

The members of the board considered an application for moderate sedation permit.

Motion by Dr. Grimes, seconded Dr. Bradley, to approve the moderate sedation permit.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

PERMIT APPLICATION

The board considered applications for general anesthesia permits.

Motion by Dr. Bradley, seconded Dr. Grimes, to approve the deep sedation/general anesthesia permits as recommended.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Dr. Edward Murray has applied for a waiver to the sedation rules regarding the moderate sedation of pediatric patients. Dr. Murray provided evidence regarding his past sedation experience in support of his waiver request.

Dr. Roth recommends the approval of Dr. Murray's waiver request.

Motion by Ms. Spillers, seconded Ms. Beasler, to approve the waiver request pending approval from the ACC of his practice and sedation history.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Dr. Humbert has also applied for a waiver of the sedation rules regarding the moderate sedation of pediatric and medically-compromised patients. Dr. Humbert currently teaches at the University of Iowa College of Dentistry. Moderate sedation is a part of the curriculum he teaches. Dr. Humbert received his training in a residency program, but he is unable to provide sufficient evidence to the length of time since the residency was completed.

Motion by Dr. Grimes, seconded Ms. Beasler, to approve the waiver request pending approval from the ACC of his training and sedation history.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

CONTINUING EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Ms. Beasler reported that the board was provided a list of the continuing education courses, which have been reviewed since the last meeting.

Ms. Beasler handed out information regarding a course titled "Understanding Personality Disorders." Ms. Beasler initially recommended awarding two hours of credit for the course. However, the sponsor has appealed the ruling. Following some discussion of the course, the Continuing Education Advisory Committee determined that the original recommendation for two hours of credit was appropriate. The sponsor appealed the decision again; therefore, the course is being forwarded to the board for consideration. The board discussed the course and how it relates to the practice of dentistry.

Motion by Dr. Rovner, seconded Ms. Spillers, to approve the committee's recommendation for two hours of credit.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

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Motion by Ms. Parsons, seconded Ms. Beasler, to recommend approval of the continuing education courses as submitted.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Ms. Beasler stated that University of Iowa College of Dentistry is an approved sponsor for continuing education. However, their flyers often do not indicate whether credit is awarded for a particular course. The board asked that sponsors be notified that they should indicate whether a course is eligible for credit, and if so, for how many hours. Ms. Braness indicated that this information could be included in the letter, which will go to sponsors as they are approved.

Ms. Braness reported that the board was provided a list of sponsors, which have applied for recertification of continuing education sponsor status. The Minnesota Dental Association has also applied for sponsor status.

Motion by Dr. Bradley, seconded Ms. Parsons, to approve the continuing education sponsors as submitted.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Ms. Hart indicated that the new database will include functionality for sponsors to provide information to licensees and the public regarding courses and other related information.

DENTAL HYGIENE COMMITTEE

Ms. Parsons indicated that she did not have a report.

ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

VOLUNTEER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER PROGRAM

Mr. McCollum reported that the Iowa Department of Public Health indicated that they would no longer be appearing today as they wished to have more time to better prepare for a meeting with the board on this matter.

BOARD MEMBERSHIPS

Mr. McCollum indicated that he has not yet received a response on the request, which was recently resubmitted for approval.

USE OF RESTALYN, BOTOX, AND OTHER DERMA FILLERS BY LICENSED DENTISTS

Ms. Hart reported that the statement regarding the use of Restalyn, Botox, and other derma fillers by licensed dentists was put out for public comment and no comments were received.

Motion by Dr. Grimes, seconded Ms. Spillers, to approve the position statement, which was previously submitted.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

COST OF INITIAL LICENSING AND RENEWAL

Mr. McCollum reported that the board regularly receives complaints regarding the licensing fees and cost of renewal in a renewal year.

Board rules essentially allow licensees to practice for “free” until the license is required to be renewed. However, some applicants feel there is some disparity between the length of time they are allowed to practice prior to renewal, depending upon the year of graduation.

Dr. Roth thinks that the fees are different based on the means of application and generally, the amount of work involved. To make it truly equitable, a license fee should be charged on top of the application fee.

Motion by Dr. Grimes, seconded Dr. Rovner, to draft rules to address this concern.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

DENTURE CLEANING SERVICES

Mr. McCollum reported that the board received a request regarding an entrepreneurial opportunity relating to denture cleaning services. Mr. McCollum spoke with Mr. Barbour and addressed some of the concerns related to billings, as well as other issues of possible concern.

Ms. Hart pointed out that the board needs to determine if this is a service, which would be permissible without supervision of a dentist.

Following a lengthy discussion of the matter, Ms. Weeg indicated that the board could send a letter to him clarifying that he would not be allowed to perform any services, which could be constituted as the practice as dentistry.

Motion by Dr. Rovner, seconded Dr. Bradley, to send a letter clarifying the limits to this service.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

CONSIDERATION OF RULES

650 IOWA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
VARIOUS CHAPTERS

Ms. Hart summarized the proposed rule changes. The rules will be eligible for adoption next week. However, the board can discuss the matter in case the board wants to make changes prior to adoption.

Ms. Hart and Mr. McCollum discussed some of the concerns related to the billing issues. It is recommended that changes be made to some of the wording, which would allow dentists to collect fees related to services as they are provided.

ANNUAL REGULATORY PLAN

Ms. Hart reported that the annual regulatory plan has been submitted for the board's approval. Ms. Hart provided an overview of prospective changes.

Motion by Dr. Rovner, seconded Ms. Spillers, to approve the annual regulatory plan as proposed.

Vote: Unanimous.

Motion carried.

LEGISLATION – 2010 SESSION

CONSIDERATION OF FELONY FOR ILLEGAL PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY

Ms. Hart reported that the request to make the illegal practice of dentistry a felony was in a bill with the Iowa Department of Public Health, which did not make it through the last legislative session. The board will again pursue this matter during the upcoming legislative session.

CORPORATE PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY

Mr. McCollum reported that Iowa was one of the few states, which does not currently regulate the corporate practice of dentistry.

Dr. Grimes put together a fact sheet regarding national trends relating to the corporate practice of dentistry. Dr. Grimes summarized the information on the fact sheet. States, at a minimum, often determine who can own a dental practice.

EXAMINATION FOR DENTAL LICENSURE

Dr. Roth reported that he would table this discussion for a later time.

APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSURE/PERMITS/REGISTRATION

PETITION FOR WAIVER

Ms. Hart reported that Dr. Ritu Bansal has submitted an application for waiver as a foreign-trained dentist. Dr. Bansal has submitted information relating to her training and education. Ms. Hart summarized past cases, which the board found acceptable for waiver.

Dr. Bansal completed a residency program in dental public health, and Dr. Bansal has the equivalent of two years of training in this area. Dr. Bansal is also board-certified in practice of dental public health. To date, Dr. Bansal has completed a clinical examination. Dr. Bansal would complete the other requirements for licensure upon approval of the waiver by the board.

Motion by Ms. Spillers, seconded Ms. Parsons, to approve the waiver request pending documentation of the equivalent of two years of training.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Ms. Hart indicated that the board received a request for a waiver of the renewal fees for Dr. Larry Book. Ms. Hart indicated that fees are not subject to waiver as board rules do not currently allow the waiver of fees.

Motion by Ms. Beasler, seconded Ms. Spillers, to deny the request.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS

The board was provided with a list of the applications for licensure, permit, and registration that have been processed since the last meeting.

Between January 14, 2010 and July 12, 2010, the board licensed 54 dentists and 71 dental hygienists; issued 9 resident dental licenses, 2 faculty permits, and 71 local anesthesia permits. The board registered 103 dental assistants with the additional qualification in dental radiography and 6 dental assistants registered without a qualification in dental radiography; and trainee status to 88 dental assistants.

Motion by Dr. Roth, seconded Dr. Curry, to approve issuance of licenses, permits, and registrations to those persons listed.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

Ms. Braness reported that Dr. Mathew Berg submitted an application for dental license by credentials. Dr. Berg has practiced in more than one state during the last three years. Board rules require three years of practice in state, or practice satisfactory to the board.

Motion by Dr. Grimes, seconded Dr. Bradley, to approve Dr. Berg's practice history, which would allow him to complete the application for license by credentials.

Vote: Unanimous.
Motion carried.

UPCOMING BOARD MEETINGS

Dr. Roth revisited upcoming board meetings. In April 2010, the board discussed meeting in Iowa City with the University of Iowa College of Dentistry in the fall. Dr. Roth proposed that with the appointment of a new executive director, among other things, that the October meeting of the board be held in Des Moines as usual.

Dr. Grimes and Dr. Roth indicated that the board should meet with the college of dentistry following the CRDTS annual meeting, and before the October 2010 board meeting in order to discuss matters relating to the clinical examinations, which are required for licensure as a dentist in the state of Iowa.

OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Dr. Roth allowed time for public comment.

CLOSED SESSION

Motion by Ms. Spillers, seconded Ms Beasler, for the board to go into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(d) and (f) to discuss and review complaints and investigative reports which are required by state law to be kept confidential and also to discuss decisions to be rendered in contested cases.





Do you need to complete the educational training required by the Minnesota Board of Dentistry rules in order to administer nitrous oxide/oxygen inhalation analgesia? Would you like a review and update on nitrous oxide sedation?

Re: January 16-17, 2009, Expanded Function Training Course on Monitoring Nitrous Oxide

The Dental Assistant Committee met by e-mail on July 9, 2010, to discuss the Monitoring Nitrous Oxide course which you had submitted for post-approval. This course was held on January 16 and 17, 2009, at the University of Minnesota. All expanded function training courses continue to be approved by the Dental Assistant Committee with their recommendation to the full board for approval or disapproval.

All participants must meet all components of the Expanded Functions training as specified in IAC 650-20.16. At a minimum, participants must be Dental Assisting National Board certified or have at least two years experience as a clinical dental assistant to participate in the monitoring nitrous oxide course, as well as any of the other expanded function duties.

The Dental Assistant Committee wants to assure that their recommendation for approval is for "monitoring only" course and does not include the administration of nitrous oxide for dental assistants.

The Dental Assistant Committee is recommending approval of the didactic portion as submitted for six hours of continuing education, with the clinical portion of this course to be implemented within the employer dentist's office. The employer will then sign off for the clinical portion, when at least four patients are monitored under the dentist's supervision. For the lab/clinical portion of this function, two hours of continuing education is approved.

On October 14, 2010, the board approved the recommended expanded function course for Monitoring Nitrous Oxide you received on January 16-17, 2009.

Background

In April, 2010 the Board approved the filing of proposed rule amendment to Chapters 11, 13, 25 and 27. A public hearing was held on July 6, 2010. No comments were received at the public hearing. Written comments were submitted by the Iowa Dental Association (IDA). IDA expressed concern about Item 10, proposed new subrules 27.7(8) and 27.7(9). The new subrules clarify billing practices for a dentist.

The proposed rules prohibited a dentist from billing or collecting money for services not rendered. IDA was concerned that the proposed rules could unintentionally prohibit a dentist's ability to ensure payment for services that they had rendered to their patients. For example, they indicated that a dentist may incur expenses (e.g. lab procedures), whether or not the patient returns to complete the treatment, and the dentist should be permitted to obtain payment for those procedures from the patient before the dentist receives the results of the lab procedures and uses those results to treat the patient. In addition, some dentists allow patients to make voluntary prepayments prior to obtaining services to that patient will have sufficient money in the patient's account to pay for services at the time the dentist provides the services. The proposed rules would have prohibited that practice.

The final rule amendments address the concerns raised by IDA. Revised subrule 27.7(8) ~~clarify~~**clarifies** that a dentist is not prohibited from billing for services rendered, costs incurred or charges for missed appointments. Revised subrule 27.7(9) allows a dentist to bill or draw on a patient's line of credit for services rendered or actual costs incurred. A new subrule 27.7(10) was added to permit patients to voluntarily prepay for services.

Adopted and Filed

Pursuant to the authority of Iowa Code section 147.76, the Dental Board hereby adopts amendments to Chapter 11, “Licensure to Practice Dentistry or Dental Hygiene,” Chapter 13, “Special Licenses,” Chapter 25, “Continuing Education,” and Chapter 27, “Standards of Practice and Principles of Professional Ethics,” Iowa Administrative Code.

Notice of Intended Action was published in the June 16, 2010 Iowa Administrative Bulletin as ARC #8846B.

Item 1 of the amendments specifies that applications are considered active for 180 days after receipt. An applicant who does not provide all requested materials or who does not meet the requirements for a license, permit, registration, or reinstatement within 180 days must submit a new application and fee.

Items 2 through 6 require applicants for licensure or for a faculty permit to submit the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB).

Item 7 of the amendments requires applicants for a faculty permit to successfully complete the jurisprudence examination administered by the Board.

Item 8 of the amendments eliminates the requirement that Board sponsors submit attendance records for continuing education courses. Continuing education providers must provide proof of attendance to course attendees and make records available at the request of the Board.

Item 9 of the amendments clarifies that an applicant for reinstatement of an inactive license must provide proof of current CPR certification to place the license on active status.

Item 10 of the amendments clarifies acceptable billing practices for a dentist.

Items 11 and 12 of the amendments clarify that it is considered unethical and unprofessional conduct to prohibit a patient from filing a complaint with the Board or cooperating with a Board

investigation and to enter into an agreement in which a patient agrees not to file a complaint with the Board.

These amendments are subject to waiver at the sole discretion of the Board in accordance with 650—Chapter 7. However, rules in 650—Chapter 27 are not subject to waiver pursuant to 650—27.12(17A,147,153,272C).

A public hearing was held on July 6, 2010. No comments were received at the public hearing. Written comments were submitted by the Iowa Dental Association (IDA). The proposed rules would have prohibited that practice.

The following changes have been made in the final rule amendments to address the concerns raised by IDA:

- Subrule 27.7(8) was revised to delete the phrase “or collect money” and a sentence was added to clarify that a dentist is not prohibited from billing for services rendered, costs incurred or charges for missed appointments. The final new subrule reads as follows:

27.7(8) A dentist shall not bill for services not rendered. A dentist shall not be prohibited from billing for those services which have been rendered, for actual costs incurred in the

treatment of the patient, or for charges for missed appointments.

- Subrule 27.7(9) was revised by the addition of a sentence that allows a dentist to draw on a patient's line of credit for services rendered or actual costs incurred. The final new subrule reads as follows:

27.7(9) A dentist shall not bill or draw on a patient's line of credit prior to services being rendered. A dentist may bill or draw on a patient's line of credit for those services which have been rendered or for actual costs incurred in the treatment of the patient.

- A new subrule 27.7(10) was added to clarify that a dentist is not prohibited from accepting voluntary prepayments from patients for dental services not yet rendered. The final subrule reads as follows:

27.7(10) A dentist shall not be prohibited from permitting patients to prepay for services, in whole or in part, on a voluntary basis.

The Iowa Dental Board adopted these rule amendments on October ~~15~~14, 2010.

These rule amendments will become effective on December 8, 2010.

These amendments are intended to implement Iowa Code sections 153.33 and 153.34.

The following amendments are adopted.

ITEM 1. Amend rule 650—11.1(147,153) as follows:

650—11.1(147,153) Applicant responsibilities. An applicant for dental or dental hygiene licensure bears full responsibility for each of the following:

1. and 2. No change.

3. Submitting complete application materials. An application for a license, permit, or registration or reinstatement of a license or registration will be considered active for 180 days from the date the application is received. If the applicant does not submit all materials, including a completed fingerprint packet, within this time period, or if the applicant does not meet the requirements for the license, permit, registration or reinstatement, the application shall be considered incomplete. An applicant whose application is filed incomplete must submit a new application and application fee.

ITEM 2. Amend paragraph 11.2(2)“f” as follows:

f. A statement disclosing and explaining any disciplinary actions, investigations, complaints, malpractice claims, judgments, settlements, or criminal charges, including the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB).

ITEM 3. Amend paragraph 11.3(2)“g” as follows:

g. A statement disclosing and explaining any disciplinary actions, investigations, malpractice claims, complaints, judgments, settlements, or criminal charges, including the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB).

ITEM 4. Amend paragraph 11.5(2)“i” as follows:

i. A statement disclosing and explaining any disciplinary actions, investigations, complaints, malpractice claims, judgments, settlements, or criminal charges, including the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank

(HIPDB).

ITEM 5. Amend paragraph **11.6(2)“g”** as follows:

g. A statement disclosing and explaining any disciplinary actions, investigations, complaints, malpractice claims, judgments, settlements, or criminal charges, including the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB).

ITEM 6. Amend paragraph **13.2(2)“e”** as follows:

e. A statement disclosing and explaining any disciplinary actions, investigations, complaints, malpractice claims, judgments, settlements, or criminal charges, including the results of a self-query of the National Practitioners Data Bank (NPDB) and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB).

ITEM 7. Adopt the following **new** paragraph **13.2(2)“j”**:

j. Evidence of successful completion of the jurisprudence examination administered by the Iowa dental board.

ITEM 8. Amend subrule 25.4(3) as follows:

25.4(3) The person or organization sponsoring continuing education activities shall make a written record of the Iowa licensees or registrants in attendance ~~and send a signed copy of such attendance record to the board office upon completion of the activity, but in no case later than July 1 of even-numbered years, maintain the written record for a minimum of five years, and submit the record upon the request of the board. The report shall be sent to the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners, 400 S.W. 8th Street, Suite D, Des Moines, Iowa 50309-4687.~~ The sponsor of the continuing education activity shall also provide proof of attendance and the number of credit hours awarded to the licensee or registrant who participates in the continuing education activity.

ITEM 9. Adopt the following **new** paragraph **25.9(2)“e”**:

e. Evidence that the applicant possesses a current certificate in a nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation. The course must include a clinical component.

ITEM 10. Adopt the following **new** subrules 27.7(8), ~~and 27.7(9)~~ **and 27.7(10)**:

27.7(8) A dentist shall not bill for services not rendered. A dentist shall not be prohibited from billing for those services which have been rendered, for actual costs incurred in the treatment of the patient, or for charges for missed appointments.

27.7(9) A dentist shall not bill or draw on a patient's line of credit prior to services being rendered. A dentist may bill or draw on a patient's line of credit for those services which have been rendered or for actual costs incurred in the treatment of the patient.

27.7(10) A dentist shall not be prohibited from permitting patients to prepay for services, in whole or in part, on a voluntary basis.

ITEM 11. Adopt the following **new** subrule 27.9(5):

27.9(5) Prohibiting a person from filing or interfering with a person's filing a complaint with the board is considered unethical and unprofessional conduct.

ITEM 12. Adopt the following **new** subrule 27.9(6):

27.9(6) A licensee shall not enter into any agreement with a patient that **states** the patient will not file a complaint with the board.

Dear Ms. Hart:

This firm serves as counsel to the Iowa Dental Association (the “Association”). The Association represents nearly ninety percent of all dentists practicing in the state of Iowa. It has come to the attention of the Association that the Iowa Dental Board (the “Board”) recently proposed new rules (the “Proposed Rules”) related to licensing of dentists and dental hygienists, which Proposed Rules are located at ARC 8846B. The Association is generally supportive of the Proposed Rules, but has some concerns regarding Item 10 of the Proposed Rules related to billing practices of dentists.

Item 10 of the Proposed Rules provides that “[a] dentist shall not bill or collect money for services not rendered.” It also provides that “[a] dentist shall not bill or draw on a patient’s line of credit prior to services being rendered.”

The Association is concerned that, as currently drafted, these prohibitions may interfere with the ability of dentists to ensure payment for services that they render to their patients. For example, dentists often require patients to make a payment for certain lab procedures. When dentists order lab procedures, the dentists incur the expense of these procedures regardless of whether the patient returns to complete the treatment. The dentist should be permitted to obtain a payment for these procedures from the patient before the dentist receives the results of the lab procedures and uses these results to treat the patient. In addition, some dentists allow patients to make voluntary prepayments prior to obtaining services so that the patient will have sufficient money in the patient’s account to pay for the services at the time the dentist provides the services. As currently drafted, the Proposed Rules may prohibit this practice.



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In situations that involve multiple appointments to complete a particular service, the patient may appear for one or more initial appointments, but then fail to return to complete the treatment. The prohibitions in Item 10 of the Proposed Rules should be modified to clarify that the dentist can bill for the portion of the services rendered, even if the dentist is unable to complete the full course of treatment as a result of a patient's failure to perform. The restrictions contained in Item 10 may also limit a dentist's ability to charge patients for missed appointments. It is the policy of some dental practices to bill a patient if the patient fails to show up for a scheduled appointment without notifying the dental practice. When a patient fails to show up for an appointment without notifying the dental practice, the dental practice may be unable to fill that time slot at the last minute. Since no service is rendered in this situation—due entirely to the failure of the patient to perform—these policies may be prohibited under the Proposed Rules.

The Association respectfully requests that the Board consider these comments and amend Item 10 of the Proposed Rules accordingly. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions regarding these comments.

Background

Agencies periodically review their rules to determine if there is a need for updates. As a result of a recent review of the rules, several areas that need to be updated have been identified such as changing the name from “Iowa Board of Dental Examiners” to “Iowa Dental Board”, updating references to Iowa Code provisions, and clarifying administrative procedures.

As part of the new database that will be implemented in upcoming months, board staff is also reviewing the administrative steps involved in all IDB procedures (e.g. licensure, registration, continuing education, and renewals). The rules may need to be updated to correspond to procedures to be followed as part of the new database workflow.

At the July, 2010 Board meeting the board asked staff to revise the rules to allow for a prorating of renewal fees. Administrative rule Chapter 15, Fees, has been reviewed and recommended rule amendments are attached for the Board’s consideration.

The Anesthesia Credentials Committee met on September 14, 2010. Administrative rule Chapter 29, Sedation and Nitrous Oxide Inhalation Analgesia, was reviewed by the Committee and recommended rule amendments are attached for the Board’s consideration.

- b. Standard data list on diskette, \$55 per profession requested.

650—15.7(147,153) Returned checks. The board shall charge a fee of \$25 for a check returned for any reason. If a license or registration had been issued by the board office based on a check that is later returned by the bank, the board shall request payment by certified check or money order. If the fees are not paid within two weeks of notification of the returned check by certified mail, the licensee or registrant shall be subject to disciplinary action for noncompliance with board rules.

CHAPTER 29
SEDATION AND NITROUS OXIDE INHALATION ANALGESIA

[Prior to 5/18/88, Dental Examiners, Board of[320]]

650—29.1 (153) Definitions. For the purpose of these rules, relative to the administration of deep sedation/general anesthesia, moderate sedation, minimal sedation, and nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia by licensed dentists, the following definitions shall apply:

"Antianxiety premedication" means minimal sedation. A dentist providing minimal sedation must meet the requirements of rule 650—29.7(153).

"ASA" refers to the American Society of Anesthesiologists Patient Physical Status Classification System. Category 1 means normal healthy patients, and category 2 means patients with mild systemic disease. Category 3 means patients with moderate systemic disease, and category 4 means patients with severe systemic disease that is a constant threat to life.

"Committee" or "ACC" means the anesthesia credentials committee of the board.

"Conscious sedation" means moderate sedation.

"Board" means the Iowa dental board established in Iowa Code section 147.14(d).

"Deep sedation/general anesthesia" is a controlled state of unconsciousness, produced by a pharmacologic agent, accompanied by a partial or complete loss of protective reflexes, including inability to independently maintain an airway and respond purposefully to physical stimulation or verbal command.

"Facility" means a dental office, clinic, dental school, or other location where sedation is used.

"Maximum recommended dose (MRD)" means the maximum FDA-recommended dose of a drug as printed in FDA-approved labeling for unmonitored home use.

"Minimal sedation" means a minimally depressed level of consciousness, produced by a pharmacological method, that retains the patient's ability to independently and continuously maintain an airway and respond normally to tactile stimulation and verbal command. Although cognitive function and coordination may be modestly impaired, ventilatory and cardiovascular functions are unaffected. The term "minimal sedation" also means "antianxiety premedication" or "anxiolysis." A dentist providing minimal sedation shall meet the requirements of rule 650—29.7(153).

"Moderate sedation" means a drug-induced depression of consciousness, either by enteral or parenteral means, during which patients respond purposefully to verbal commands, either alone or accompanied by light tactile stimulation. No interventions are required to maintain a patent airway and spontaneous ventilation is adequate. Cardiovascular function is usually maintained. Prior to January 1, 2010, moderate sedation was referred to as conscious sedation.

"Monitoring nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia" means continually observing the patient receiving nitrous oxide and recognizing and notifying the dentist of any adverse reactions or complications.

"Nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia" refers to the administration by inhalation of a combination of nitrous oxide and oxygen producing an altered level of consciousness that retains the patient's ability to independently and continuously maintain an airway and respond appropriately to physical stimulation or verbal command.

"Pediatric" means patients aged 12 or under.

650—29.2 (153) Prohibitions.

29.2(1) Deep sedation/general anesthesia. Dentists licensed in this state shall not administer deep sedation/general anesthesia in the practice of dentistry until they have obtained a permit ~~as required by the provisions of this chapter.~~ Dentists shall only administer deep sedation/general anesthesia in a facility that has successfully passed inspection as required by the provisions of this chapter.

29.2(2) Moderate sedation. Dentists licensed in this state shall not administer moderate sedation in the practice of dentistry until they have obtained a permit ~~as required by the provisions of this chapter.~~ Dentists shall only administer moderate sedation in a facility that has successfully passed inspection as required by the provisions of this chapter.

29.2(3) Nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia. Dentists licensed in this state shall not administer nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia in the practice of dentistry until they have complied with the provisions of rule 650—29.6(153).

29.2(4) Antianxiety premedication. Dentists licensed in this state shall not administer antianxiety premedication in the practice of dentistry until they have complied with the provisions of rule 650—29.7(153).

650—29.3 (153) Requirements for the issuance of deep sedation/general anesthesia permits.

29.3(1) A permit may be issued to a licensed dentist to use deep sedation/general anesthesia on an outpatient basis for dental patients provided the dentist meets the following requirements:

a. Has successfully completed an advanced education program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation that provides training in deep sedation and general anesthesia; and

b. Has formal training in airway management; and

c. Has completed a minimum of one year of advanced training in anesthesiology and related academic subjects beyond the undergraduate dental school level in a training program approved by the board.

d. Has completed a peer review evaluation, as may be required by the committee, prior to issuance of a permit.

29.3(2) A dentist using deep sedation/general anesthesia shall maintain a properly equipped facility at each facility where sedation is administered. The dentist shall maintain and be trained on the following equipment at each facility where sedation is provided: ~~anesthesia or analgesia machine,~~ EKG monitor, positive pressure oxygen, suction, laryngoscope and blades, endotracheal tubes, magill forceps, oral airways, stethoscope, blood pressure monitoring device, pulse oximeter, emergency drugs, defibrillator. A licensee may submit a request to the board for an exemption from any of the provisions of this subrule. Exemption requests will be considered by the board on an individual basis and shall be granted only if the board determines that there is a reasonable basis for the exemption.

29.3(3) The dentist shall ensure that each facility where sedation services are provided is permanently equipped pursuant to subrule 29.3(2), and is staffed with trained auxiliary personnel capable of reasonably handling procedures, problems and emergencies incident to the administration of general anesthesia. Auxiliary personnel shall maintain current certification in basic life support and be capable of administering basic life support.

29.3(4) A dentist administering deep sedation/general anesthesia must document and maintain current, successful completion of an Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) course.

29.3(5) A dentist who is performing a procedure for which deep sedation/general anesthesia was induced shall not administer the general anesthetic and monitor the patient without the presence and assistance of at least two qualified auxiliary personnel in the room who are qualified under subrule 29.3(3).

29.3(6) A dentist qualified to administer deep sedation/general anesthesia under this rule may administer moderate sedation and nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia provided the dentist meets the requirements of rule 650—29.6(153).

29.3(7) A licensed dentist who has been utilizing deep sedation/general anesthesia in a competent manner for the five-year period preceding July 9, 1986, but has not had the benefit of formal training as outlined in this rule, may apply for a permit provided the dentist fulfills the provisions set forth in 29.3(2), 29.3(3), 29.3(4), and 29.3(5).

650—29.4 (153) Requirements for the issuance of moderate sedation permits.

29.4(1) A permit may be issued to a licensed dentist to use moderate sedation for dental patients provided the dentist meets the following requirements:

a. Has successfully completed a training program approved by the board that meets the American Dental Association Guidelines for Teaching Pain Control and Sedation to Dentists and Dental Students and that consists of a minimum of 60 hours of instruction and management of at least 20 patients; and

b. Has formal training in airway management; or

c. Has submitted evidence of successful completion of an accredited residency program that includes formal training and clinical experience in moderate sedation, which is approved by the board.

d. Has completed a peer review evaluation, as may be required by the committee, prior to issuance of a permit.

29.4(2) A dentist utilizing moderate sedation shall maintain a properly equipped facility. The dentist shall maintain and be trained on the following equipment at each facility where sedation is provided: ~~anesthesia or analgesia machine~~, EKG monitor, positive pressure oxygen, suction, laryngoscope and blades, endotracheal tubes, magill forceps, oral airways, stethoscope, blood pressure monitoring device, pulse oximeter, emergency drugs, defibrillator. A licensee may submit a request to the board for an exemption from any of the provisions of this subrule. Exemption requests will be considered by the board on an individual basis and shall be granted only if the board determines that there is a reasonable basis for the exemption.

29.4(3) The dentist shall ensure that each facility where sedation services are provided is permanently equipped pursuant to subrule 29.3(2), and staffed with trained auxiliary personnel capable of reasonably handling procedures, problems and emergencies incident to the administration of general anesthesia. Auxiliary personnel shall maintain current certification in basic life support and be capable of administering basic life support.

29.4(4) A dentist administering moderate sedation must document and maintain current, successful completion of an Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) course.

29.4(5) A dentist who is performing a procedure for which moderate sedation is being employed shall not administer the pharmacologic agents and monitor the patient without the presence and assistance of at least one qualified auxiliary personnel in the room who is qualified under subrule 29.4(3).

29.4(6) A licensed dentist who has been utilizing moderate sedation on an outpatient basis in a competent manner for five years preceding July 9, 1986, but has not had the benefit of formal training as outlined in this rule, may apply for a permit provided the dentist fulfills the provisions set forth in subrules 29.4(2), 29.4(3), 29.4(4) and 29.4(5).

29.4(7) Dentists qualified to administer moderate sedation may administer nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia provided they meet the requirement of rule 650—29.6(153).

29.4(8) If moderate sedation results in a general anesthetic state, the rules for deep sedation/general anesthesia apply.

29.4(9) A dentist utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients must have completed an accredited residency program that includes formal training in anesthesia and clinical experience in managing pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients. A dentist who does not meet the requirements of this subrule is prohibited from utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients.

650—29.5 (153) Permit holders.

29.5(1) No dentist shall use or permit the use of deep sedation/general anesthesia or moderate sedation ~~in a dental office~~ for dental patients, unless the dentist possesses a current permit issued by the ~~Iowa board of dental examiners~~. No dentist shall use or permit the use of deep sedation/general anesthesia for dental patients in a facility that has not successfully passed an equipment inspection pursuant to the requirements of 29.3(2). A dentist holding a permit shall be subject to periodic peer review and facility inspection as at a frequency deemed appropriate by the board.

29.5(2) An application for a deep sedation/general anesthesia permit must include the appropriate fee as specified in 650—Chapter 15, as well as evidence indicating compliance with rule 650—29.3(153).

29.5(3) An application for a moderate sedation permit must include the appropriate fee as specified in 650—Chapter 15, as well as evidence indicating compliance with rule 650—29.4(153).

29.5(4) If an applicant will be practicing at a facility that has been previously inspected and approved by the board, a provisional permit may be granted to the applicant upon the recommendation of the anesthesia credentials committee after review of the applicant's credentials.

29.5(5) If a facility has not been previously inspected, no permit shall be issued until the facility has been inspected and successfully passed.

29.5(6) 29.5(5) Permits shall be renewed biennially at the time of license renewal following submission of proper application and may involve board reevaluation of credentials, facilities, equipment, personnel, and procedures of a previously qualified dentist to determine if the dentist is still qualified. The appropriate fee for renewal as specified in 650—Chapter 15 of these rules must accompany the application.

29.5(7) 29.5(6) Upon the recommendation of the anesthesia credentials committee that is based on the evaluation of credentials, facilities, equipment, personnel and procedures of a dentist, the board may determine that restrictions may be placed on a permit.

29.5(8) 29.5(7) The actual costs associated with the on-site evaluation of the facility shall be the primary responsibility of the licensee. The cost to the licensee shall not exceed \$500 per facility.

29.5(9) ~~29.5(8)~~ Permit holders shall follow the American Dental Association's guidelines for the use of sedation and general anesthesia for dentists, except as otherwise specified in these rules.

29.5(10) ~~29.5(9)~~ A dentist utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients must have completed an accredited residency program that includes formal training in anesthesia and clinical experience in managing pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients. A dentist who does not meet the requirements of this subrule is prohibited from utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients.

650—29.6 (153) Nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia.

29.6(1) A dentist may use nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia sedation on an outpatient basis for dental patients provided the dentist:

- a. Has completed a board approved course of training; or
- b. Has training equivalent to that required in 29.6(1) "a" while a student in an accredited school of dentistry, and
- c. Has adequate equipment with fail-safe features and minimum oxygen flow which meets FDA standards.
- d. Has routine inspection, calibration, and maintenance on equipment performed every two years and maintains documentation of such, and provides documentation to the board upon request.
- e. Ensures the patient is continually monitored by qualified personnel while receiving nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia.

29.6(2) A dentist utilizing nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia shall be trained and capable of administering basic life support, as demonstrated by current certification in a nationally recognized course in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

29.6(3) A licensed dentist who has been utilizing nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia in a dental office in a competent manner for the 12-month period preceding July 9, 1986, but has not had the benefit of formal training outlined in paragraph 29.6(1) "a" or 29.6(1) "b," may continue the use provided the dentist fulfills the requirements of paragraphs 29.6(1) "c" and "d" and subrule 29.6(2).

29.6(4) A dental hygienist may administer nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia provided the administration of nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia has been delegated by a dentist and the hygienist meets the following qualifications:

- a. Has completed a board-approved course of training; or
- b. Has training equivalent to that required in 29.6(4) "a" while a student in an accredited school of dental hygiene.

29.6(5) A dental hygienist or registered dental assistant may monitor a patient under nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia provided all of the following requirements are met:

- a. The hygienist or registered dental assistant has completed a board-approved course of training or has received equivalent training while a student in an accredited school of dental hygiene or dental assisting;
- b. The task has been delegated by a dentist and is performed under the direct supervision of a dentist;
- c. Any adverse reactions are reported to the supervising dentist immediately; and
- d. The dentist dismisses the patient following completion of the procedure.

29.6(6) A dentist who delegates the administration of nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia in accordance with 29.6(4) shall provide direct supervision and establish a written office protocol

for taking vital signs, adjusting anesthetic concentrations, and addressing emergency situations that may arise.

29.6(7) If the dentist intends to achieve a state of moderate sedation from the administration of nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia, the rules for moderate sedation apply.

650—29.7 (153) Minimal sedation.

29.7(1) The term “minimal sedation” also means “antianxiety premedication” or “anxiolysis.”

29.7(2) If a dentist intends to achieve a state of moderate sedation from the administration of minimal sedation, the rules for moderate sedation shall apply.

29.7(3) A dentist utilizing minimal sedation and the dentist’s auxiliary personnel shall be trained in and capable of administering basic life support.

29.7(4) Minimal sedation for adults.

a. Minimal sedation for adults is limited to a dentist’s prescribing or administering a single enteral drug that is no more than 1.0 times the maximum recommended dose (MRD) of a drug that can be prescribed for unmonitored home use. A single supplemental dose of the same drug may be administered, provided the supplemental dose is no more than one-half of the initial dose and the dentist does not administer the supplemental dose until the dentist has determined the clinical half-life of the initial dose has passed.

b. The total aggregate dose shall not exceed 1.5 times the MRD on the day of treatment.

c. For adult patients, a dentist may also utilize nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia in combination with a single enteral drug.

d. Combining two or more enteral drugs, excluding nitrous oxide, prescribing or administering drugs that are not recommended for unmonitored home use, or administering any intravenous drug constitutes moderate sedation and requires that the dentist must hold a moderate sedation permit.

29.7(5) Minimal sedation for ASA category 3 or 4 patients or pediatric patients.

a. Minimal sedation for ASA category 3 or 4 patients or pediatric patients is limited to a dentist’s prescribing or administering a single dose of a single enteral drug that can be prescribed for unmonitored home use and that is no more than 1.0 times the maximum recommended dose.

b. A dentist may administer nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia for minimal sedation of ASA category 3 or 4 patients or pediatric patients provided the concentration does not exceed 50 percent and is not used in combination with any other drug.

c. The use of one or more enteral drugs in combination with nitrous oxide, the use of more than a single enteral drug, or the administration of any intravenous drug in ASA category 3 or 4 patients or pediatric patients constitutes moderate sedation and requires that the dentist must hold a moderate sedation permit.

29.7(6) A dentist providing minimal sedation shall not bill for non-IV conscious or moderate sedation.

29.7(7) A dentist shall ensure that any advertisements related to the availability of antianxiety premedication, anxiolysis, or minimal sedation clearly reflect the level of sedation provided and are not misleading.

650—29.8 (153) Noncompliance. Violations of the provisions of this chapter may result in revocation or suspension of the dentist’s permit or other disciplinary measures as deemed appropriate by the board.

650—29.9 (153) Reporting of adverse occurrences related to sedation, nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia, and antianxiety premedication.

29.9(1) Reporting. All licensed dentists in the practice of dentistry in this state must submit a report within a period of seven days to the board office of any mortality or other incident which results in temporary or permanent physical or mental injury requiring hospitalization of the patient during, or as a result of, antianxiety premedication, nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia, or sedation. The report shall include responses to at least the following:

- a. Description of dental procedure.
- b. Description of preoperative physical condition of patient.
- c. List of drugs and dosage administered.
- d. Description, in detail, of techniques utilized in administering the drugs utilized.
- e. Description of adverse occurrence:
 1. Description, in detail, of symptoms of any complications, to include but not be limited to onset, and type of symptoms in patient.
 2. Treatment instituted on the patient.
 3. Response of the patient to the treatment.
- f. Description of the patient's condition on termination of any procedures undertaken.

29.9(2) Failure to report. Failure to comply with subrule 29.9(1), when the occurrence is related to the use of sedation, nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia, or antianxiety premedication, may result in the dentist's loss of authorization to administer sedation, nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia, or antianxiety premedication or in any other sanction provided by law.

650—29.10 (153) Anesthesia credentials committee.

29.10(1) The anesthesia credentials committee is a peer review committee appointed by the board to assist the board in the administration of this chapter. This committee shall be chaired by a member of the board and shall include at least six additional members who are licensed to practice dentistry in Iowa. At least four members of the committee shall hold deep sedation/general anesthesia or ~~conscious-moderate~~ sedation permits issued under this chapter.

29.10(2) The anesthesia credentials committee shall perform the following duties at the request of the board:

- a. Review all permit applications and make recommendations to the board regarding those applications.
- b. Conduct site visits at facilities under subrule 29.5(1) and report the results of those site visits to the board. The anesthesia credentials committee may submit recommendations to the board regarding the appropriate nature and frequency of site visits.
- c. Perform professional evaluations and report the results of those evaluations to the board.
- d. Other duties as delegated by the board or board chairperson.

650—29.11 (153) Review of permit applications.

29.11(1) Review by board staff. Upon receipt of a completed application, the application will be reviewed by board staff for eligibility and forwarded to the anesthesia credentials committee for review.

29.11(2) Review by the anesthesia credentials committee (ACC).

a. Committee review. Following review and consideration of an application the ACC may at its discretion:

1. Request additional information;

2. Request an investigation;
3. Request that the applicant appear for an interview;
4. Recommend issuance of the permit;
5. Recommend issuance of the permit under certain terms and conditions or with certain restrictions;
6. Recommend denial of the permit; or
7. Refer the permit application to the board for review and consideration without recommendation.
8. Request a peer review evaluation.

b. Provisional permit. If an application is recommended for approval by the ACC, staff will administratively issue a provisional permit. A provisional permit authorizes the applicant to administer moderate sedation or deep sedation/general anesthesia on the terms and conditions specified by the ACC, pending final approval by the board.

29.11(3) Review by board. The board shall consider applications and recommendations from the ACC. The board shall:

1. Request additional information;
2. Request an investigation;
3. Request that the applicant appear for an interview;
4. Grant the permit;
5. Grant the permit under certain terms and conditions or with certain restrictions; or
6. Deny a permit.

29.11 (4) Right to defer action if pending investigation or discipline. The ACC or board may defer final action on an application if there is an investigation or disciplinary action pending against an applicant, who may otherwise meet the requirements for permit until such time as ACC or board is satisfied that issuance of a permit to the applicant poses no risk to the health and safety of Iowans.

29.11 (5) Appeal process for denials. If a permit application is denied, an applicant may file an appeal of the final decision using the process described in rule 650—11.10(147).

650—29.1129.12 (153) Renewal. A permit to administer deep sedation/general anesthesia or moderate sedation shall be renewed biennially at the time of license renewal. ~~Prior to July 1, 2008, permits expired on June 30 of every even-numbered year. A permit due to expire June 30, 2008, shall be automatically extended until August 30, 2008, and expire August 31, 2008. Beginning July 1, 2008, Ppermits expire August 31 of every even-numbered year.~~

29.1129.12(1) To renew a permit, a licensee must submit the following:

- a.* Evidence of renewal of ACLS certification.
- b.* A minimum of six hours of continuing education in the area of sedation. These hours may also be submitted as part of license renewal requirements.
- c.* The appropriate fee for renewal as specified in 650—Chapter 15.

29.1129.12(2) Failure to renew the permit prior to November 1 following its expiration shall cause the permit to lapse and become invalid for practice.

~~29.11~~29.12(3) A permit that has been lapsed may be reinstated upon submission of a new application for a permit in compliance with rule 29.5(153) and payment of the application fee as specified in 650—Chapter 15.

650—29.13 (147, 153, 272C) Grounds for nonrenewal. A request to renew a permit may be denied on any of the following grounds:

29.13(1) After proper notice and hearing, for a violation of these rules or Iowa Code chapter 147, 153, or 272C during the term of the last permit renewal.

29.13(2) Failure to pay required fees.

29.13(3) Failure to obtain required continuing education.

29.13(4) Failure to provide documentation of current ACLS certification.

29.13(5) Failure to provide documentation of maintaining a properly equipped facility.

29.13(6) Receipt of a certificate of noncompliance from the college student aid commission or the child support recovery unit of the department of human services in accordance with 650—chapter 33 and 650—Chapter 34.

650—29.12 (153) Rules for denial or nonrenewal.

~~A dentist who has been denied a deep sedation/general anesthesia or moderate sedation permit or renewal may appeal the denial and request a hearing on the issues related to the permit or renewal denial by serving a notice of appeal and request for hearing upon the executive director not more than 30 days following the date of the mailing of the notification of the permit or renewal denial, or not more than 30 days following the date upon which the dentist was served notice if notification was made in the manner of service of an original notice. The hearing shall be considered a contested case proceeding and shall be governed by the procedures set forth in 650 IAC 51.~~

650—29.13~~29.14~~ (153) **Record keeping.**

29.13~~29.14~~(1) *Minimal sedation.* An appropriate sedative record must be maintained and must contain the names of all drugs administered, including local anesthetics and nitrous oxide, dosages, time administered, and monitored physiological parameters, including oxygenation, ventilation, and circulation.

29.13~~29.14~~(2) *Moderate or deep sedation.* The patient chart must include preoperative and postoperative vital signs, drugs administered, dosage administered, anesthesia time in minutes, and monitors used. Pulse oximetry, heart rate, respiratory rate, and blood pressure must be recorded continually until the patient is fully ambulatory. The chart should contain the name of the person to whom the patient was discharged.

29.13~~29.14~~(3) *Nitrous oxide inhalation analgesia.* The patient chart must include the concentration administered and duration of administration, as well as any vital signs taken.

Background

Dr. James Townsend submitted a petition for waiver on July 30, 2010 requesting a permanent waiver of the following Board rule:

29.4(9) A dentist utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients must have completed an accredited residency program that includes formal training in anesthesia and clinical experience in managing pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients. A dentist who does not meet the requirements of this subrule is prohibited from utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients.

Dr. Townsend would like a permit to use moderate sedation on pediatric or medically compromised patients but he has not completed an accredited residency program with the required formal training specified in the rule. In lieu of an accredited residency program with the required formal training Dr. Townsend is requesting that the Board review and accept the education, training and clinical experience he describes in his petition (see attached). Dr. Townsend has previously practiced in Waterloo but he is currently not practicing dentistry in Iowa.

Board rules provide a procedure by which an individual may request waiver of a Board rule. The criteria used to determine if a waiver should be granted are:

7.4(4) Criteria for waiver. In response to a petition completed pursuant to subrule 7.4(6), the board may in its sole discretion issue an order waiving in whole or in part the requirements of a rule if the board finds, based on clear and convincing evidence, all of the following: *a.* The application of the rule would impose an undue hardship on the person for whom the waiver is requested; *b.* The waiver from the requirements of the rule in the specific case would not prejudice the substantial legal rights of any person; *c.* The provisions of the rule subject to the petition for a waiver are not specifically mandated by statute or another provision of law; and *d.* Substantially equal protection of public health, safety, and welfare will be afforded by a means other than that prescribed in the particular rule for which the waiver is requested.

Committee Recommendation

Approve the rule waiver with the following conditions: (1) Dr. Townsend must provide written notice to the board office upon his return to practice in Iowa, and (2) prior to issuance of a moderate sedation permit, Dr. Townsend may be subject to a peer review evaluation and facility inspection upon his return to practice in Iowa.

Proposed Motion

I move that the Board accept the Anesthesia Credentials Committee's recommendation to approve the rule waiver on the terms described in this Report to the Board.

2. I am requesting a waiver of 650 Iowa Administrative Code subrule 29.4 (9), which states, "A dentist utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients must have completed an accredited residency program that includes formal training in anesthesia and clinical experience in managing pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients. A dentist who does not meet the requirements of the subrule is prohibited from utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients."

3. Describe the specific waiver, including the precise scope and time period for which the waiver will extend: I would like the Board to grant me a permanent waiver to 650 IAC subrule 29.4(9), which prohibits a dentist from utilizing moderate sedation on pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients unless the dentist has completed an accredited residency program. In lieu of compliance with this subrule, I would like the board to accept the following education, training, and clinical experience so I can provide and utilize moderate sedation in managing pediatric and/or ASA category 3 or 4 patients. I completed a GPR with the US Army Dental Corps in July 1981 that included a 3 month rotation in oral surgery where I trained and provided care utilizing I.V. Sedation. I was then stationed in Frankfurt, Germany where I was sent to the 97th General Hospital where I completed a year of training in Anesthesia and Exodontia in August 1982. During this training I spent the AM in the OR providing general anesthesia services for all levels of ASA cases and ages. The PMs were spent in the Oral Surgery Clinic providing Oral Surgery services utilizing I.V. Sedation. When I completed the training, I went to the Hansa Allee Dental Clinic also in Frankfurt, Germany, where I was the Chief of the Clinic's Oral Surgery Services and provided surgical care for all levels of ASA cases and ages extensively utilizing I.V. sedation until I left the military in June 1984.

I then entered private practice in Waterloo, Iowa where as a General Dentist I provided a wide range of service for both pediatric and medically-compromised patients for

24 years having performed over 3000 sedation procedures without even one adverse event.

In Sept. of 2008, I reentered the US Army Dental corps and was stationed at Ft. Campbell, KY where I serve as the Chief of the Oral Surgery Service at Taylor Dental Clinic. I am credentialed and perform I.V. sedation procedures here for the soldiers.

4. Explain the relevant facts and reasons that the petitioner believes justify a waiver. Include in your answer all the following:

a. Undue Hardship. Compliance with the rule would impose an undue hardship caused by the time, expense and burden to complete an accredited residency program when I have the same or similar background, training and experience in providing sedation to these patient groups.

Not applicable. See entry above.

b. Why Waiving the Rule Would not Prejudice the Substantial Legal Rights of Any Person. Waiver of the rule would not prejudice the substantial legal rights of any person because I have substantially the same or similar education and experience as that required in the rule. This ensures and protects the public health, safety and welfare of any person.

c. The Provisions of the Rule to the Waiver are NOT Specifically Mandated by Statute or Another Provision of Law. Iowa Code Chapter 153 does not mandate the requirements of rule 650-29.4(9) (153).

d. Substantially Equal Protection of the Public Health, Safety, and Welfare has been afforded. The subrule that I am requesting a waiver from helps to ensure that dentists who provide moderate sedation to pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients have received additional training beyond the minimal level of training required for managing healthy adult patients, as recommended by the American Dental Association. In lieu of completing an accredited residency program that includes formal training in anesthesia and clinical experience in managing pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients, I have the following substantially same or similar background, training and experience in managing these patient groups. See Above. Additionally, I have performed I.V. sedation procedures for almost 30 years, done over 3000 cases without even one adverse event or malpractice claim brought against me.

The documentation from the program directors of the residency programs I participated in close to 30 years ago, that you requested, there is no way to contact them nor does the military maintain records that far back. I have included copies of the documents that I did retain: General Practice Residency Certificate; DA Form 67-8 (OER) period 12 June 1982 to 11 June 1983; DA form 67-8 (OER) period 12 June 1983 to 1

May 1984; Letter of Commendation dated 12 April 1984; Letter of recommendation dated 29 Oct 2007 from Dr. Bradley L. Townsend; Letter of recommendation dated 10/30/07 from Dr. Brian Bouck and Delineation of Clinical Privileges- Dentistry dated 22 April 2009. I hope this additional documentation will be adequate for the Anesthesia Credentials Committee to extend the credentials I have requested and comply with IAC 29.4(9).

Protocols and procedures for selecting pediatric or ASA 3 or 4 patients as candidates for moderate sedation are as follows; Patients subjected to parenteral conscious sedation must be suitably evaluated prior to the start of any sedation procedure. With those pediatric patients or patients who may not be medically stable consultation with their primary care physician or consulting medical specialist regarding potential risk or special monitoring requirements is required. All potential adverse affects associated with the delivery of any sedative, inhalation or narcotic agent must be reviewed with the patient/guardian prior to any procedure and appropriate informed consent is obtained.

Protocols and procedures for the administration of moderate sedation for pediatric or ASA category 3 or 4 patients are as follows: the escort has to be identified by name and remain in the waiting room. The surgical procedure and sedation process are reviewed and informed consent obtained. Equipment to provide airway management and advanced life support are on the premises and all equipment is checked prior to the start of the procedure. The patient's oxygenation (O2 monitor), EKG (cardiac monitoring) and breathing either by auscultation of the breathe sounds or by direct clinical observation are provided. Appropriate time-oriented anesthetic records are maintained. Oxygen and suction equipment are continuously available at recovery and discharge. Patients are not discharged until meets criteria. Patient's are not dismissed until they can ambulate on their own. They are dismissed to the care of their escort and a staff member assists them to their car. Typical drugs used are diazepam, midazolam, phenergan, fentanyl and/or meperidine. Dexamethasone may be used for its anit-inflammatory activity if approved in adult patients. Narcan and Romazicon are available as opioid and benzodiazepine antagonists respectively. Appropriate titration of medications is accomplished. A vital signs baseline is accomplished pre and post-op and every 5 minutes intra-op. Post-op instructions, both verbal and written, are not given until the patient is coherent enough to understand them with the escort present. They are also given after hours contact phone numbers.

5. A history of prior contacts between the board and petitioner related to the regulated activity is as follows:

None-only yearly renewal prior to 2010.

6. Information related to the board's action in similar cases: The board has received no similar requests for waiver of this subrule.

7. There is no other public agency or political subdivision that regulates dentistry in Iowa.

8. I am not aware of any person or entity that would be adversely affected by the granting of a waiver in this case.

I am writing a letter of recommendation for Dr. James D. Townsend based on my close working relationship with him during his 23 years of practice in Waterloo, Iowa.



ACTION REQUESTED: Approval to Proceed with Proposed Legislation

Background

The Iowa Dental Board has indicated it is considering seeking a statutory amendment that would state that persons who practice dentistry without a license would, upon conviction, be guilty of a class D felony. Currently, practicing dentistry illegally is only a serious misdemeanor. The public safety concern the statutory amendment would address is situations where a dentist may have his/her license revoked in one state and move to Iowa and start practicing illegally. In the past, the board has encountered a situation where a county prosecutor was reluctant to pursue a case because the crime was only a misdemeanor and the county had limited resources.

The potential public safety concern warrants such practice to be designated as a felony. The Iowa Board of Medicine has a similar statute found at Iowa Code section 148.6(3).

Proposed Statutory Amendment

The proposed change would amend Iowa Code section 153.17 to add the following new section:

4. A person who engages in the practice of dentistry without a license or who violates the provisions of sections 147.84 or 147.85 shall upon conviction be guilty of a class “D” felony.

This language closely mirrors that used by the Iowa Board of Medicine. Sections 147.84 and 147.85 that would be referenced in the above amendment relate to fraud in procuring a license by presenting a false diploma.

Proposed Motion

I move that the board direct staff to proceed with a legislative amendment to make practicing dentistry without a license a felony.

Background

To meet the Board's requirements for licensure by examination, Board rules specify that applicants must complete the examination administered by the American Board of Dental Examiners, Inc. (ADEX), the Central Regional Dental Testing Service, Inc. (CRDTS), or the Western Regional Examining Board, Inc. (WREB).

There have been discussions at prior board meetings about the comparative strengths and weaknesses of the CRDTS and WREB examinations. At the October meeting there will be an opportunity for the board to continue discussions with the University of Iowa College of Dentistry about the two examinations currently accepted by the Board.

Background

Iowa law prohibits a member of a regulatory board (i.e. the Iowa Dental Board) from selling or leasing, either directly or indirectly, any goods or services to individuals, associations, or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the Board except as authorized by Iowa Code section 68B.4 and the administrative rules adopted by the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board at 351 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 6.11.

An Iowa Dental Board member may only sell or lease goods or services to individuals, associations or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the Board on the terms and conditions approved by Board. Other State regulatory boards have adopted resolutions to evidence their consent, within specific parameters, to sales and leases by their board members.

A regulatory agency granting consent to such sale or lease of goods and services must file a copy of the consent with the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board (IECDB) within twenty days of the consent being granted. The Consent is then posted on the IECDB website.

The Iowa Dental Board has also adopted administrative rules, 650 IAC Chapter 8, that govern the sale of goods and services by Board members. (Copy attached)

Attached is a copy of a proposed resolution that consents to board members selling goods and services to individuals, associations, or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the Board provided the board member meets the specific conditions listed.

Proposed Motion

I move that the Board adopt the attached Resolution for Consent to Sales and Leases of Goods and Services.

CONSENT TO SALES AND LEASES OF GOODS AND SERVICES

The Iowa Dental Board (Board) is established in Iowa Code sections 147.13. The Board is comprised of nine members appointed by the Governor . The Board regulates the practice of dentists, dental hygienists and dental assistants. For organizational, administrative and budgetary purposes only the Board is part of the Iowa Department of Public Health (Department). Pursuant to Iowa Code section 68B.4, Board members shall not sell or lease, either directly or indirectly, any goods or services to individuals, associations, or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the Board except as authorized by Iowa Code section 68B.4 and the administrative rules adopted by the Iowa Ethics and Campaign Disclosure Board at 351 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) 6.11.

On the _____ day of October, 2010, the Board granted consent for members of the Board to sell or lease goods and services as follows:

1. Members of the Board may sell or lease goods or services to any individual, association or corporation regulated by any division within the Department, other than the Board on which that official serves. This consent is granted because such sale or lease of goods or services does not affect the Board member's duties or functions on the Board.
2. Members of the Board may sell or lease goods or services to any individual, association, or corporation regulated by the Board if those goods or services are routinely provided to the public as part of that person's regular professional practice. This consent is granted because the sale or lease of such goods or services does not affect the Board member's duties or functions on the Board. In the event a complaint is filed with the Board concerning the services or goods provided by a Board member to any member of the public, the Board member is prohibited from participating in a decision by the Board in that case. See, for example, Code of Administrative Judicial Conduct, 11 IAC 10.29(3)(b).
3. Individual application and approval are not required for the sales or leases authorized by this Consent unless there are unique facts surrounding a particular sale or lease that would cause the sale or lease to affect the seller's or lessor's duties or functions on the Board, would give the buyer or lessee an advantage in dealing with the Board, or would otherwise present a conflict of interest as defined in Iowa Code section 68B.2A or the common law.
4. Individual application and approval, when required, shall conform to the procedures and guidelines outlined in 351 IAC 6.11

CHAPTER 8
SALE OF GOODS AND SERVICES

650—8.1(68B) Selling of goods or services by members of the board. The board members shall not sell, either directly or indirectly, any goods or services to individuals, associations, or corporations that are subject to the regulatory authority of the department of public health except as authorized by this chapter.

650—8.2(68B) Conditions of consent for members.

8.2(1) Consent shall be given by a majority of the members of the board. Consent shall not be given to an official to sell goods or services to an individual, association, or corporation regulated by the department of public health unless all of the following conditions are met:

- a. The official requesting consent does not have authority to determine whether consent should be given.
- b. The official's duties or functions are not related to the department's regulatory authority over the individual, association or corporation to whom the goods and services are being sold, or the selling of the good or service does not affect the official's duties or functions.
- c. The selling of the good or service does not include acting as an advocate on behalf of the individual, association, or corporation to the department of public health.
- d. The selling of the good or service does not result in the official selling a good or service to the department on behalf of the individual, association, or corporation.

8.2(2) Authorized sales.

a. A member of the board may sell goods or services to any individual, association, or corporation regulated by any division within the department of public health, other than the board on which that official serves. This consent is granted because the sale of such goods or services does not affect the board member's duties or functions on the board.

b. A member of the board may sell goods or services to any individual, association, or corporation regulated by the board if those goods or services are routinely provided to the public as part of that person's regular professional practice. This consent is granted because the sale of such goods or services does not affect the board member's duties or functions on the board. In the event an individual, association, or corporation regulated by the board, to whom a board member sells goods or services is directly involved in any matter pending before the board, including a disciplinary matter, that board member shall not participate in any deliberation or decision concerning that matter. In the event a complaint is filed with the board concerning the services provided by the board member to a member of the public, that board member is otherwise prohibited by law from participating in any discussion or decision by the licensing board in that case.

c. Individual application and approval are not required for the sales authorized by this rule unless there are unique facts surrounding a particular sale which would cause the sale to affect the seller's duties or functions, would give the buyer an advantage in dealing with the board, or would otherwise present a conflict of interest.

8.2(3) Application for consent. Prior to selling a good or service to an individual, association, or corporation subject to the regulatory authority of the department of public health, an official must obtain prior written consent unless the sale is specifically allowed in subrule 8.2(2). The request for consent must be in writing signed by the official requesting consent. The application must provide a clear statement of all relevant facts concerning the sale. The application should identify the parties to the sale and the amount of compensation. The application should also explain why the sale should be allowed.

8.2(4) Limitation of consent. Consent shall be in writing and shall be valid only for the activities and the time period specifically described in the consent. Consent can be revoked at any time by a majority vote of the members of the board upon written notice to the board. A consent provided under this chapter does not constitute authorization for any activity which is a conflict of interest under common law or which would violate any other statute or rule.

It is the responsibility of the official requesting consent to ensure compliance with all other applicable laws and rules.

These rules are intended to implement Iowa Code section 68B.4.

On October 27, 2010 the Board voted to deny Dr. Hastings application for a dental license. A Preliminary Notice of Denial was forwarded to Dr. Hastings on December 14, 2009.

The Board's administrative rule allow for a 30-day period within which an applicant can appeal a preliminary denial of licensure. Dr. Hastings initially appealed the Board's decision; however, he later withdrew his appeal. The 30-day period has passed and the board office has not received a notice to resubmit the appeal. Board rule 11. 10(4) provides that: "If an applicant does not appeal a preliminary notice of denial, the preliminary notice of denial automatically becomes final and a notice of denial will be issued."
