I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER – JUNE 8, 2016

II. COMMITTEE MINUTES

- *April 13, 2016 – Teleconference*

- ❖ MOVED by ELMITT, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to APPROVE the minutes as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

III. CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

- *University of Iowa College of Dentistry – “Culturally Responsive Health Care in Iowa 2016” – Requested 6.5 hours*

The committee members questioned some of the topics included in this course, and to what extent they were applicable to the practice of dentistry. Dr. McBride discussed this with Ms. Stuecker. Ms. Braness reported that these courses have been approved in the past; though, the University of Iowa College of Dentistry provided more detailed information than had been provided previously.

The committee members were concerned about awarding full credit based on the information provided.

- ❖ MOVED by BEASLER, SECONDED by FULLER, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- *Christopher M. Aldrich, D.D.S., P.L.L.C. – “New Patients/Patient Communication” – Requested 3 hours*
- *Christopher M. Aldrich, D.D.S., P.L.L.C. – “Scheduling for Patient Care/Treatment Planning” – Requested 3 hours*

Ms. Schlievert believed that these courses focused on practice management. The committee members agreed.

- ❖ MOVED by FULLER SECONDED by STREAM, to DENY the courses as submitted since the focus of the courses was practice management. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

Ms. Malmberg had a question about the statement related to the topics that were acceptable. Specifically, Ms. Malmberg had a question about how “sexual boundaries” would be defined. Ms. Braness stated that this is not clearly defined in the rule. Based on courses that she’s seen, Ms. Braness believed that the intent is to discuss the doctor-patient relationship, and what would be acceptable practice. In some cases, the courses may be presented as a way to discuss this information with licensees who might have been disciplined for these types of issues.
