I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER – MARCH 1, 2017

The meeting of the Continuing Education Advisory Committee was called to order at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 1, 2017. The meeting was held by electronic means in compliance with Iowa Code section 21.8. The purpose of the meeting was to review meeting minutes, requests for continuing education course and sponsor approval, and other committee-related matters. It was impractical to meet in person with such a short agenda.

A quorum was established with five (5) members present.

II. COMMITTEE MINUTES

- *January 11, 2017 – Teleconference*

- ❖ MOVED by ELMITT, SECONDED by FULLER, to APPROVE the minutes as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

III. CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

- AppleWhite Dental Partners – *“Invisalign Update - 2016”* Requested 2.5 hours.

Dr. McBride did not believe that there was sufficient information to award continuing education hours for the course. The speaker was a business representative; therefore, it was unclear as to whether this would be clinically related, or more focused on marketing and revenue. Ms. Beasler agreed.

- ❖ MOVED by BEASLER, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to DENY the course as being related to the business aspects of practice, and to allow resubmission with additional information. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- AppleWhite Dental Partners – *“Incorporating Sleep-Disordered Breathing Into Your Dental Practice”* – Requested 2.5 hours.

Ms. Beasler believed that some of the content would qualify; however, some of the topics are clearly related to business aspects of practice. Ms. Schlievert agreed.

Dr. McBride believed that most of the course was clinically-based. Ms. Beasler was in favor of partial credit, though she was unsure about how much to award credit. Dr. McBride recommended two (2) hours of credit.

- ❖ MOVED by MCBRIDE, SECONDED by BEASLER, to APPROVE the course for two (2) hours of credit. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Periodontal Specialists, P.A. – *Fall 2017 Meeting: “Hot & Bothered! Science & Strategies for Managing Oral & Systemic Inflammation” & “The Perfect Handoff! Communication Strategies for Stellar Co-Diagnosis & Enrollment* – Requested 6 hours.

Ms. Braness reported that Ms. Malmberg was in favor getting additional information prior to making a final decision. The committee members agreed, in part.

- ❖ MOVED by BEASLER, SECONDED by ELMITT, to APPROVE the course *“Hot & Bothered! Science & Strategies for Managing Oral & Systemic Inflammation”* for three (3) hours; and to REQUEST ADDITIONAL INFORMATION on the course, *“The Perfect Handoff! Communication Strategies for Stellar Co-Diagnosis & Enrollment.”* Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Randall Toothaker, D.D.S. – *“Communication and Fatigue to Fulfillment”* – Requested 6 hours.

Ms. Braness reported that Ms. Malmberg requested additional information as the request only briefly referenced clinical application. The committee members agreed.

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the course.

Ms. Schlievert believed that some of the content met the guidelines for approval. Ms. Beasler stated that recordkeeping was eligible for continuing education credit. Dr. Hipp clarified that the intent of the course was designed to encourage practitioners to provide more information in the record.
