TIME, PLACE AND NATURE OF HEARING

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a disciplinary contested case hearing be held on April 4, 2006, before the full Board of Dental Examiners or a panel of the Board. The hearing shall begin at 3:00 p.m. and shall be located in the 1st floor conference room, Iowa Board of Dental Examiners office at 400 SW 8th Street, Ste D, Des Moines, Iowa. The Board shall serve as presiding officer, but the Board may request an Administrative Law Judge make initial rulings on prehearing matters, and be present to assist and advise the Board at hearing.

Within twenty (20) days of the date you are served this Notice of Hearing you are required by 650 Iowa Administrative Code 51.12(2) to file an Answer. In that Answer, you should also state whether you will require an adjustment of the date and time of the hearing. At hearing, you may appear personally or be represented by counsel at your own expense. You will be allowed the opportunity to respond to the charges against you. The

procedural rules governing the conduct of the hearing are found at 650 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 51.

The office of the Attorney General is responsible for representing the public interest (the State) in this proceeding. Pleadings shall be filed with the Board and copies should be provided to counsel for the State at the following address: Theresa O'Connell Weeg, Assistant Attorney General, Iowa Attorney General's Office, 2nd Floor, Hoover State Office Building, Des Moines, Iowa 50319.

LEGAL AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION

The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 147, 153 and 272C (2005). If any of the allegations against you are founded, the Board has authority to take disciplinary action against you under Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 147, 153, and 272C (2005) and 650 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 51. If you fail to appear at the hearing, the Board may enter a default decision or proceed with the hearing and render a decision in your absence, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 17A.12(3) and 650 Iowa Administrative Code 51.22.

SECTIONS OF STATUTES AND RULES INVOLVED AND STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

Respondent is currently issued Registration number Q08168 to engage in the practice of dental assisting, subject to the laws of the state of Iowa and rules of the Board of Dental Examiners. Respondent's registration is current and will expire June 30, 2007.

Respondent is charged under Iowa Code Section 153.34(4) (2005) with repeated violations of the rules of the Board by failing to comply with universal precautions for preventing transmission of infectious diseases as issued by the Centers for Disease

Control of the United States Department of Health and Human Services (CDC) in violation of 650 Iowa Administrative Code Section 30.4(35).

The allegations giving rise to this Notice of Hearing are set forth in a document which has been reviewed and approved by the Board as part of this Notice of Hearing. The document is not a public record in accordance with a recent court decision but will be made available to you upon application.

This matter may be resolved by settlement agreement. The procedural rules governing the Board's settlement process are found at 650 Iowa Administrative Code 51.19. If you are interested in pursuing settlement of this matter, please contact Constance L. Price, Executive Director.
