NOTICE OF HEARING, SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

(combined)

COMES NOW the Iowa Dental Board (the Board), and Stanley N. Margul, D.D.S., (Respondent), on April 23, 2008, and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10(2) and 272C.3(4), enter into the following combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order.

NOTICE OF HEARING

1. A hearing on this matter will not be held as the Board and Respondent have entered into the following combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order.
2. Respondent was issued license number 7428 by the Board to engage in the practice of dentistry, subject to the laws of the state of Iowa and the rules of the Board.
3. License number 7428 is current and expires August 31, 2008.

LEGAL AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION

4. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 153 and 272C (2007).

SECTIONS OF STATUTES AND RULES INVOLVED

COUNT I

5. Respondent is charged under Iowa Code Section 153.34(11) with having disciplinary action taken by a licensing authority of another state.

STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED

6. On May 19, 2007, Respondent entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Missouri Dental Board.
7. According to the Settlement Agreement:
 - a. Respondent administered general anesthesia for a period of time on an expired permit.
 - b. Respondent failed to maintain an annual inventory of controlled substances and records required by law for controlled substances at the registered office location in Missouri, but rather only maintained such documents at his office in Illinois. Respondent also failed to properly dispose of controlled substances and maintain adequate procedures to detect and prevent diversion.
8. Respondent's Missouri dental license was placed on probation for a period of five (5) years during which time Respondent must adhere to numerous probationary terms.

9. Respondent's office in Iowa was inspected and no violations were found.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

10. **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent's Iowa Dental License shall immediately be placed on probation for the period of time Respondent is on probation under the May 19, 2007, Settlement Agreement of the Missouri Dental Board.
11. Prior to the Board releasing the Respondent from the terms of this Order, the Respondent shall be required to document successful completion of the Missouri Dental Board Settlement Agreement.
12. In the event Respondent retires from practice in Iowa and places his license on inactive status, he may request the Board terminate his probation and release Respondent from all other terms of this Order.
13. Respondent shall fully cooperate with random unannounced visits by agents of the Board.
14. Respondent shall fully disclose this Order to all current and future employees and/or employers. Respondent shall report back to the Board with signed statements from all such employees and employers within fourteen (14) days of the date of this Order, and thereafter within fourteen (14) days of any new employment relationship, indicating that they have read this Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order and understand the current terms and conditions placed on Respondent's dental license.

15. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs associated with compliance with this Order, and shall also be responsible for all costs incurred by the Board in the monitoring of this Order to determine compliance. Respondent shall promptly remit one hundred (\$100.00) dollars on or before the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year for such costs while on probation.
16. Respondent shall upon reasonable notice, and subject to the provisions of 650 Iowa Administrative Code 31.6, appear before the Board at the time and place designated by the Board.
17. Notice of any change of practice location must be provided to the Board within fourteen (14) days of the change.
18. Respondent shall submit quarterly reports to the Board detailing compliance with the terms and conditions of this Order. Respondent shall ensure that the reports are submitted prior to the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year.

FINAL ORDER

19. This combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order constitutes the resolution of a contested case proceeding.
20. By entering into this combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing on the allegations contained in the Notice of Hearing, and waives any objections to the terms of this Settlement Agreement.

21. This combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order, is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for consideration.
22. Respondent acknowledges that he has the right to be represented by counsel in this matter.
23. This combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement, and Final Order become public records available for inspection and copying upon execution of this agreement in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.
24. Respondent understands that the Board is required by Federal law to report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank and Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.
25. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured him, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
26. This combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order, is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
27. The Board's approval of this combined Notice of Hearing, Settlement Agreement and Final Order shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.


