I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER – MARCH 6, 2015

The meeting of the Continuing Education Advisory Committee was called to order at 12:02 p.m. on Friday, March 6, 2015. II. CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

- Mississippi Valley Oral Surgery – “*Managing Anesthesia in the Office (600 series)*” – Requested 15 hours for completion of all components, 601-610

Ms. Cacioppo believed it was a good course; however, there was not enough information for dental practitioners. Ms. Cacioppo recommended denying continuing education credit. The other committee members agreed.

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the request. The committee first reviewed this course at the January 13, 2015 meeting. The Iowa Dental Hygienists' Association appeared to have reworked the course to more closely meet requirements for approval.

Ms. Cacioppo stated that it appeared that they went back to the presenter for more information and restructuring. Ms. Cacioppo liked that the Iowa Dental Hygienists' Association added information about health histories and the impact of patients' behaviors on treatment. Ms. Cacioppo was in favor of the changes. Ms. Elmitt agreed.
