I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER – MARCH 2, 2016

The meeting of the Continuing Education Advisory Committee was called to order at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 2, 2016. The meeting was held by electronic means in compliance with Iowa Code section 21.8. The purpose of the meeting was to review meeting minutes, requests for continuing education course and sponsor approval, and other committee-related matters. It was impractical to meet in person with such a short agenda. A quorum was established with six (6) members present.

II. COMMITTEE MINUTES

- *January 13, 2016 – Teleconference*
- ❖ MOVED by ELMITT, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to APPROVE the minutes as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

III. CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

- Iowa Dental Association – “*Designed for Accomplishment; Engineered for Success (1st Session)*” – Requested 3 hours.
- Iowa Dental Association – “*Designed for Accomplishment; Engineered for Success (2nd Session)*” – Requested 3 hours.

Ms. Braness reported that this request was reviewed at the last meeting of the committee. The committee asked for additional information, which the Iowa Dental Association submitted for consideration.

- ❖ MOVED by FULLER, SECONDED by STREAM, to APPROVE the courses as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Iowa Dental Association – “*Lunch and Learn*” – Requested 1 hour for each session.
 - *Simplified Extractions and Socket Grafting Techniques*
 - *The Versatility of Locators in Your Practice*
 - *What Do We Know About Cracked Teeth*
 - *Periodontal Solutions for Everyday Practice: Change the Microenvironment and Address the Biofilm Cause*
 - *Oral Cancer Screening with VELscope Vx*

Ms. Braness reported that this request was reviewed at the last meeting of the committee. The committee asked for additional information, which the Iowa Dental Association submitted for consideration.

- ❖ MOVED by FULLER, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to APPROVE the courses as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Joan Stover – “*Iowa Governor’s Conference on Public Health 2016*” – Requested 2 hours, 1 hour for each course resubmitted.
 - “*Community Recruitment and Collaboration for a Strong Dental Workforce*”
 - “*I-Smile Silver: A Community-Based Pilot Project for the Oral Health of Older Iowans*”

Ms. Braness reported that this was reviewed at the last meeting of the committee. The committee asked for additional information, which Ms. Stover submitted for consideration.

Ms. Beasler asked about the basis of approval for the courses. Dr. Fuller referenced the definition of “dental public health” as an ADA-recognized specialty in Iowa Administrative Code 650—Chapter 28. Iowa Administrative Code 650—Chapter 25 awards continuing education credit to

courses, which address specialties as listed in chapter 28. Ms. Stuecker provided additional clarification of the definition, and summarized the discussion that she had with the Board's attorney about this matter.

Ms. Schlievert agreed with Ms. Stuecker's comments. Ms. Schlievert requested that the course "*Iowa Direct Care Workforce Initiatives*" be awarded credit as well. The course is specific to oral health training for dental professionals to serve patients in nursing homes. Ms. Schlievert inquired if she could request to have this added to the list of courses for which credit would be awarded. Ms. Braness stated that since Ms. Stover was managing this program and made the request to seek approval, the review should be limited to the courses, which she requested.

❖ MOVED by FULLER, SECONDED by SCHLIEVERT, to APPROVE the courses as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- CNA – "*Dental Professional Liability Risk Management Seminar*" – Requested 4.5 hours

Ms. Braness shared Ms. Malmberg's comments regarding this course. Ms. Malmberg had concerns about the focus of the course. Ms. Braness stated that Iowa Administrative Code 650—25.3(7) allows continuing education credit for courses that focus on risk management.

Ms. Beasler mentioned the record keeping portion of the course, which was also eligible for continuing education credit.

Ms. Schlievert asked about the length of the course as a basis for their request for 4.5 hours of credit. Ms. Schlievert had not noticed the date and time of the course in the materials.

Ms. Braness stated that the committee had a couple of options for addressing this. The committee could request additional information prior to making a recommendation.

❖ MOVED by MCBRIDE, SECONDED by ELMITT, to REQUEST additional information regarding the length of course in clock hours. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- North Central District of Iowa Dental Association – "*Periodontal Disease: From Probing to Presenting to Planning*" – Requested 3 hours

❖ MOVED by FULLER, SECONDED by ELMITT, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- Midlands Dental Group – "*Prosthodontics for the General Dentist*" – Requested 2 hours
- Midlands Dental Group – "*Soft Tissue Management*" – Requested 2 hours
- Midlands Dental Group – "*Post and Core Techniques*" – Requested 2 hours

Ms. Schlievert indicated that the course materials did not provide much information with respect to the qualifications of the speaker(s) and the length of the courses as a basis for determining continuing education credit.

- ❖ MOVED by BEASLER, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to REQUEST additional information about the qualifications of the speaker(s) and the length of the courses in clock hours. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Dental Professionals Resource Group, LLC – *“Oral Pathology Review: “Red-Blue Lesions of the Oral Cavity””* – Requested 2 hours
- ❖ MOVED by STREAM, SECONDED by FULLER, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Iowa Dental Hygienists' Association – *“Tongue-Tied: A Story Not Silenced by Oral Cancer”* – Requested 3 hours
- ❖ MOVED by SCHLIEVERT, SECONDED by FULLER, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- Iowa Department of Public Health – *“I-Smile Coordinator Training”* – Requested 2 hours
- ❖ MOVED by ELMITT, SECONDED by MCBRIDE, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

Ms. Schlievert stated that she was confused about the intended topic of the course, as it appeared that there were changes.

Dr. McBride noted that there were two courses, and that the name had been changed for this particular course. Dr. McBride believed the two topics were correlated.

Ms. Beasler believed that the agenda and timeframe were not provided. Dr. McBride stated that the brochure indicated the course would be presented from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
