COMES NOW the Iowa Dental Board (the Board), and Trevor S. Clemons, D.D.S. (Respondent), on April 6th, 2010, and enter into the following Stipulated License Agreement.

1. On December 21, 2009, Respondent made application to the Iowa Dental Board for a dental license.
2. The Board reviewed the dental license application and concluded that Respondent has engaged in the following unethical and unprofessional conduct:
 - a. On June 29, 2004, Respondent failed to provide effective controls and procedures to guard against theft and diversion of controlled substance (triazolam) in his office. Subsequently, a patient stole 16 tablets of triazolam that was unsecured.
 - b. An inspection of the Respondent's office was conducted and found that no safe guards were in place to protect controlled substances, and that proper record keeping for dispensing of controlled substances was not maintained.

- c. To address these issues, Respondent entered into a settlement agreement with the Missouri Dental Board. The Missouri Dental Board placed terms and conditions on Respondent's dental license for a period of 18 months which are incorporated below.
- d. The Respondent is also licensed to practice dentistry in Kansas. The Respondent entered into a Stipulation and Consent Order with the Kansas Dental Board which was issued April 21, 2009, in response to the action in Missouri. The Kansas Order required the applicant to demonstrate compliance with the Missouri Dental Board Order.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent's dental license shall be placed on probation for a period of one year effective the date of this Order. During that time the Respondent shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

SECTION I.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Respondent shall successfully pass the Board's jurisprudence exam prior to engaging in practice in the state of Iowa.
2. Respondent shall remain in full compliance with all of the terms and conditions set forth in the Missouri Settlement Agreement.
3. Respondent shall submit quarterly reports detailing his compliance with the terms of his Order during the remainder of his probationary period. Respondent shall ensure that the reports are submitted prior to the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year during the probationary period.


4. Respondent shall authorize the Missouri Dental Board to provide the Iowa Dental Board full and complete documentation and information regarding the Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of his Missouri Order.
5. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs associated with compliance with this agreement, and shall also be responsible for all costs incurred by the Board in the monitoring of this agreement to determine compliance. Respondent shall promptly remit one hundred (\$100.00) dollars on or before the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year for monitoring costs.
6. Respondent shall fully cooperate with the Board to determine compliance with this Agreement.
7. Respondent acknowledges that he has read in its entirety the foregoing Stipulated Registration Agreement and that he understands its content and that he executed the Agreement freely and voluntarily.
8. Respondent acknowledges that he has the right to be represented by counsel in this matter.
9. Respondent understands that this Agreement is a public record and is therefore subject to inspection and copying by members of the public.
10. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured him in any way whatsoever to execute this Agreement.
11. This License Agreement is subject to approval of the Board. If the Board fails to approve this License Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.


12. The Board's approval of this License Agreement shall constitute a **Final Order** of the Board.
13. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating the practice of dentistry in Iowa. Any violation of this Agreement is grounds for formal disciplinary action, upon notice and opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 272C.3(2)(a)(2009).

This License Agreement is voluntarily submitted on this 16 day of MARCH, 2010.
