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**NOW** on this 29th day of April, 2016, the Board considered a written request from Respondent for the Board to terminate all probationary requirements from his January 22, 2015 Settlement Agreement and Final Order (“Order”) which states that Respondent may request termination of his probation following one (1) year of successful compliance with the terms of the Order.

In considering Respondent’s request, the Board reviewed the letter submitted by Respondent, the disciplinary charges and January 22, 2015 Order, and probation information.

The January 22, 2015 Order resolved charges of failure to maintain a satisfactory standard of competency in the practice of dentistry and failing to maintain patient records in a manner consistent with the protection of the welfare of the patient and placed Respondent’s license on probation for three years. The Board acknowledges that Respondent has complied with each and every term of his probation for the one year and three months that he has served of his three year probationary term, but given the nature of the charges, the Board determined it is appropriate for Respondent to remain on probation for a longer period of time. However, the Board determined to modify the January 22, 2015 Order to eliminate the requirement that Respondent have a practice monitor review his patient records and submit reports to the Board.

**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent's request for the Board to terminate his probation is **DENIED. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent shall no longer be required to have a practice monitor review his patient records and submit reports to the Board as required by Section I, paragraph 1 of the Order. All other requirements in the January 22, 2015 Settlement Agreement and Final Order shall remain in effect.
