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**STATEMENT OF CHARGES, SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT and FINAL ORDER**

**(Combined)**

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**COME NOW** the Iowa Dental Board (Board), and Mark W. Platt, D.D.S. (Respondent), and pursuant to Iowa Code sections 17A.10 and 272C.3(4), enter into the following combined Statement of Charges, Settlement Agreement and Final Order (Order).

**A. LEGAL AUTHORITY AND JURISDICTION**

1. Respondent was issued dental license 06772 in the state of Iowa on July 1, 1982.
2. Respondent's dental license is current and will expire on August 31, 2020.
3. The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code chapters 147, 153, and 272C (2018).

**B. STATEMENT OF CHARGES**

**SECTIONS OF STATUTES AND RULES INVOLVED**

**COUNT I**

4. Respondent is charged under Iowa Code section 153.34(4) and 650 IAC 30.4(1)"d" with employing or permitting a person with a lapsed license to practice dental hygiene.

#### **STATEMENT OF MATTERS ASSERTED**

5. On July 10, 2007, Respondent was disciplined by the Board with employing or permitting an unregistered person to practice dental assisting.
6. A dental hygienist whose license has lapsed is prohibited from engaging in the practice of dental hygiene, pursuant to 650 IAC 14.5(1)"c".
7. Respondent allowed a dental hygienist whose license had lapsed to continue to practice dental hygiene without a current license from November 1, 2017 to September 26, 2019.

#### **C. SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER**

##### **THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

8. Respondent asserts that the failure to note the lapse was unintentional and that they self-reported the issue as soon as it was discovered.
9. Respondent is **CITED** for employing or permitting a person with a lapsed license to practice dental hygiene and **WARNED** that future violations may result in further disciplinary action.
10. Respondent agrees to submit a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to the Board within sixty (60) days of this Order, made payable to Treasurer, State of Iowa, to be deposited in the general fund.
11. This Order constitutes the initiation and resolution of a contested case proceeding.

12. This Order is voluntarily submitted by Respondent to the Board for consideration.
13. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured him, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
14. By entering into this Order, Respondent voluntarily waives any rights to a contested case hearing and waives any objections to the terms of this Order.
15. Respondent understands that by entering into this Order, he cannot obtain a copy of the investigative file. Under Iowa Code section 272C.6(4), a copy of the investigative file may only be provided to a licensee after the initiation of a contested case proceeding and prior to its resolution.
16. Respondent acknowledges that he has the right to be represented by counsel in this matter.
17. Respondent understands that the Board is required by federal law to report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank.
18. Upon approval by the Board, this Order becomes a permanent public record available for inspection and copying, in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapters 22 and 272C.
19. This Order is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board fails to approve this Order, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
20. Upon approval by the Board, this Order shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.
