

**BEFORE THE DENTAL BOARD
OF THE STATE OF IOWA**

IN THE MATTER OF JACK ELDER, D.D.S. RESPONDENT	CASE NO. 19-0151 NOTICE OF INTENT TO LIFT STAY
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1. On November 13, 2020, the Board issued a Final Order in the above-captioned case ("Board Order").
2. The Board Order revoked Respondent's Iowa dental license, but stayed the revocation subject to Respondent's compliance with probationary terms and conditions.
3. The probationary terms and conditions required verification of completion of a board approved review and evaluation program, and successful completion of any recommended educational remediation, at an approved facility within six months.
4. D-PREP, which was a board approved review and evaluation program, was not operational at the time of the Board Order due to COVID-19 and is no longer operational.
5. On April 16, 2021, the Board provided information to Respondent regarding an alternative board approved review and evaluation program, which consisted of a written exam, a clinical exam, and an ethics exam.
6. Respondent expressed difficulty with registering for the clinical exam and was given a deadline of May 5, 2021, to provide the Board with information regarding

scheduling for the clinical exam.

7. As of July 22, 2021, the Board had not received any further communication from Respondent and sent a letter with the option to complete the review and evaluation program as previously set forth, or to complete the review and evaluation program through Promethean. Respondent was given a deadline to complete either option by September 2, 2021.
8. On September 1, 2021, Respondent requested an extension of time to complete the option offered to him in April 2021, consisting of a written exam, a clinical exam, and an ethics exam.
9. Respondent was granted an extension and given deadlines to complete registration for each exam and deadlines to complete each exam with a passing score.
10. Respondent took three components of the ethics exam and received a failing score on each component.
11. Respondent completed the first day of the clinical exam (endodontics and prosthodontics), but failed to show up for the second day of the clinical exam (periodontal scaling and restorative anterior/posterior). Respondent received failing scores for the components taken on the first day.
12. Respondent is noncompliant with the Board Order due to his failure to complete a board approved review and evaluation program.
13. The Board intends to proceed with lifting the stay and revoking Respondent's dental license.

14. The stay will be lifted automatically on December 20, 2021, unless the Board receives a written request for an evidentiary hearing by December 17, 2021.
15. In accordance with Iowa Code section 17A.18(3), if an evidentiary hearing is requested, Respondent must show compliance with all lawful requirements for the retention of his license. The evidentiary hearing will be a contested case hearing conducted in accordance with the provisions of Iowa Code chapter 17A and 650 Iowa Administrative Code chapter 51.
16. If a timely request for hearing is not received, Respondent's license will be revoked effective December 20, 2021.
