I. CALL MEETING TO ORDER – MAY 20, 2020

The meeting of the Continuing Education Advisory Committee was called to order at 12:01 p.m. on Wednesday, May 20, 2020. The meeting was held by electronic means in compliance with Iowa Code section 21.8 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The purpose of the meeting was to review requests for continuing education course approval and other committee-related matters.

A quorum was established with five members present.

II. OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Ms. Braness allowed the opportunity for public comment.

No comments were received.

III. CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

- *DOCS Education: “IV Sedation Dentistry” – Requested 90 hours.*

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the request. Ms. Braness noted that the review of this course by the Continuing Education Advisory Committee was only for the purposes of determining continuing education credit. Approval of this training course for the purposes of obtaining a moderate sedation permit in Iowa will be considered by the Anesthesia Credentials Committee at a later date.

Dr. McBride stated the course appeared robust. The committee briefly discussed the number of hours that would be awarded. The committee would like to include a recommendation that the licensees who complete this course also complete additional continuing education for a well-rounded approach.

- ❖ MOVED by MCBRIDE, SECONDED by ELMITT, to APPROVE the course as submitted with a recommendation for additional continuing education. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- *Emily Boge, CE ZOOM, PACE: “COVID-EO Conference” – Requested 10 hours.*

Ms. Braness reported that a number of licensees and registrants inquired about this course during the period when a lot of dental offices were closed due to COVID-19. Ms. Braness believed that this appeared to meet the requirements for approval. Ms. Chickering agreed.

- ❖ MOVED by CHICKERING, SECONDED by MALMBERG, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- *Britta Alpen, Chicago Dental Society: “Change Your Thoughts to Improve Your Outcomes” – Requested 3 hours.*
- *Britta Alpen, Chicago Dental Society: “Periodontal Co-Therapist” – Requested 3 hours.*

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the course request. Unfortunately, a limited amount of information was available. Ms. Braness attempted research the course on the convention’s website; however, there was not much information available.

Ms. Malmberg believed that part of this may focus on patient education; however, it is unclear if that is the case.

Ms. Braness stated that since this was a request for post approval, the committee could request additional information without delaying the availability of the course.

- ❖ MOVED by MILLER, SECONDED by MALMBERG, to REQUEST ADDITIONAL INFORMATION about the courses. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

- *CE Impact & Iowa Board of Pharmacy: “Modernizing the PMP: Updates to the Iowa Prescription Drug Monitoring Program” – Requested 1 hour.*

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the request. This was a course developed and presented by the Iowa Board of Pharmacy.

- ❖ MOVED by ELMITT, SECONDED by MALMBERG, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.
- *Iowa Dental Association; Laurie Owens, CPC, CPB: “The Critical Role of Teledentistry” – Requested 1 hour.*

Ms. Braness stated that this course may relevant for providing treatment during the COVID-19 response. Ms. Malmberg agreed.

- ❖ MOVED by MALMBERG, SECONDED by CHICKERING, to APPROVE the course as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSE APPLICATIONS REVIEWED BY BOARD STAFF

- *Iowa Valley Continuing Education: “Infection Control and OSHA Guidelines for the Dental Practice” – Requested 3 hours.*
- ❖ MOVED by MALMBERG, SECONDED by ELMITT, to APPROVE the course as recommended. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

IV. CONTINUING EDUCATION SPONSOR APPLICATIONS FOR REVIEW

Ms. Braness reported that the Board had not received any new sponsor applications to date.

V. EXPANDED FUNCTION REQUESTS

- *Apex Dental – Level 1 Expanded Functions:*
 - *Temporary Cementation and Recementation of Provisional Restorations*
 - *Removal of Adhesives Using Nonmotorized Hand Instrumentation*
 - *Placement of Class 1 Temporary Filling Materials*

Ms. Braness provided an overview of the request. Dr. Richtsmeier was requesting approval for the Level 1 expanded functions for which he previously received approval. The new submission takes into account the new minimum training standards.

- ❖ MOVED by MALMBERG, SECONDED by ELMITT, to APPROVE the request as submitted. Motion APPROVED unanimously.

VI. OTHER BUSINESS

- *For Discussion: Committee Appointments*

Ms. Braness noted that the Board will be reviewing committee appointments at its June 5, 2020 meeting. Ms. Beasler and Dr. Foley have indicated that they preferred to step down from the committee. Ms. Braness asked any other committee members that did not want to continue serving on the committee to let her know.
